LINDELL W. STURGIS MEMORIAL PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD

The family of the late Lindell W. Sturgis, former member and chairman of the SIU Board of Trustees, established an endowed fund in 1979 to support recognition of public service efforts by SIUC faculty and staff. The Lindell W. Sturgis Memorial Public Service Award is presented annually to an employee as recognition of his/her contributions to the community, area, state, or nation, based upon activities unrelated to job responsibilities.

AWARD

This prestigious award, including a cash gift of \$750 and a plaque, is presented by the SIU Board of Trustees at a special luncheon in early May.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Nominee must be faculty or staff of SIUC.
- Nominee's service to their community, area, state, or nation should be unrelated to their University responsibilities.
- Nominee's contribution/role must have positive impact or have fostered awareness in those areas they serve.
- Nominee should have committed substantial time to service.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- Nominator may be an SIU employee OR a member of the general public.
- Nominator should provide a clear statement of the candidate's contribution(s) as it relates to the selection criteria.
- Nominator should provide additional letters of support especially where the nomination would be for or from a supervisor or family member.
- All public service contributions should be listed in the appropriate section of nomination form.
- Nominator should provide supporting documentation of public service contribution.
- Individuals who were nominated previously, but not selected, are eligible for re-nomination. It is preferred that a new application be submitted.
